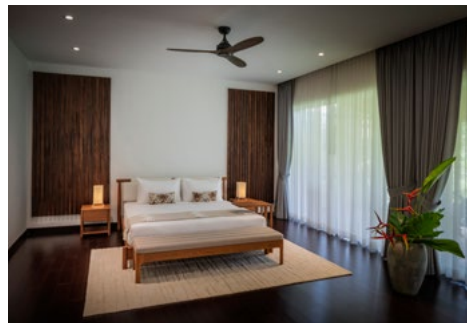

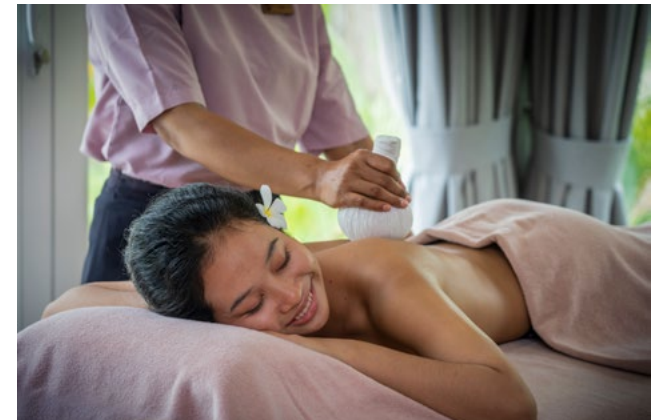

THE SANCTUARY SPA

With treatment rooms in 8 free standing buildings and the adjoining Sanctuary Café, the Spa is a real oasis amongst a wonderful tropical garden. The spa menu is extensive and ranges from classic massages and couple massages to treatments with sauna or whirlpool use. Next to the spa you will find our fully equipped gym as well as a small and two large yoga shalas and a second amazing pool.
